PHOTO TIPS

Everyone needs a great headshot, but not everyone is comfortable being photographed. Here are some tips to help you get prepared!

- Wear plain clothing – avoid patterns, prints and logos on your shirt
- A jacket is great – be sure it buttons!
- Avoid wearing clothing that is too big, flowy or baggy as this adds weight
- Make sure all buttons, hooks, zippers, etc are functional
- Make sure clothing is pressed and free of pet hair, lint, etc.
- Have your hair cut the week before your shoot
- Come to the shoot with clean, styled hair
- Gentlemen, be sure to shave or tidy up beard the morning of your shoot
- Ladies, bring your lipstick, foundation and blush for touch-ups
- Bring a brush or comb for touch-up
- HYDRATE! Start drinking water the day before your shoot
- Avoid smoking and alcohol the day and night before your shoot
- Get a good night sleep!
